Policy S.26

AMI RELOCATION OR OPT-OUT

RESPONSIBILITY: CEO and Employees

To provide a relocation for Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative Members who desire to have their Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) meter(s) relocated. Or, provide an AMI Opt-Out for Members who desire to Opt-Out of Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative's AMI system.

REQUIREMENTS: Relocation

1. Where feasible, Members may elect to have the Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative meter removed from their building /structure and relocated to a location of Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative's choosing. This option may not be feasible at all installations. Feasibility shall be determined by Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative.
2. Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative will, at its expense, shorten or reduce the amount of primary line to accommodate the new metering system.
3. Members are responsible for extension of their electrical system from the new meter location to their existing electrical system, including all materials, labor, permits, inspections, etc.
4. Required metering can be provided by either a direct meter or a sub deduct meter from an existing service.
5. Any line extension, including additional poles, equipment or other material to adjust the new meter location of Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative's choosing, will be at the Member's expense.

REQUIREMENTS: Opt-Out

1. Members may opt-out and not have an AMI meter service their property, except for the following:
 - A. Members who participate in services or optional rates that require the AMI system (Time of Use, Distributed Generation, Prepay, Controlled Electric, etc.)
 - B. Members with any record of tampering with the meter.
 - C. Members who have a poly-phase service.
 - D. Members who have received disconnect notices within 24 months prior to requesting the opt-out program.
 - E. Members who are already in the Program and receive past due notice and do not bring the account current before 8:00 am on the disconnect date listed on the notice.
 - F. Members whose meters are inaccessible to read (physical obstructions, hazardous conditions or denial of access).

2. To enroll in the Program and opt-out, a Member shall provide Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative with a written signed notification of their agreement to the terms and conditions of this policy.
 - A. Members in the program will have their meters manually read monthly by a Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative employee.
 - B. Members in the program will be assessed a meter reading fee of \$75.00 per month.
 - C. Non-AMI meters will be read near end of the month on a meter reading schedule as selected by Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative.

This policy supersedes and cancels all similar policies prior to this date.

Some information may change as a result of external factors such as new legislation or regulations.
