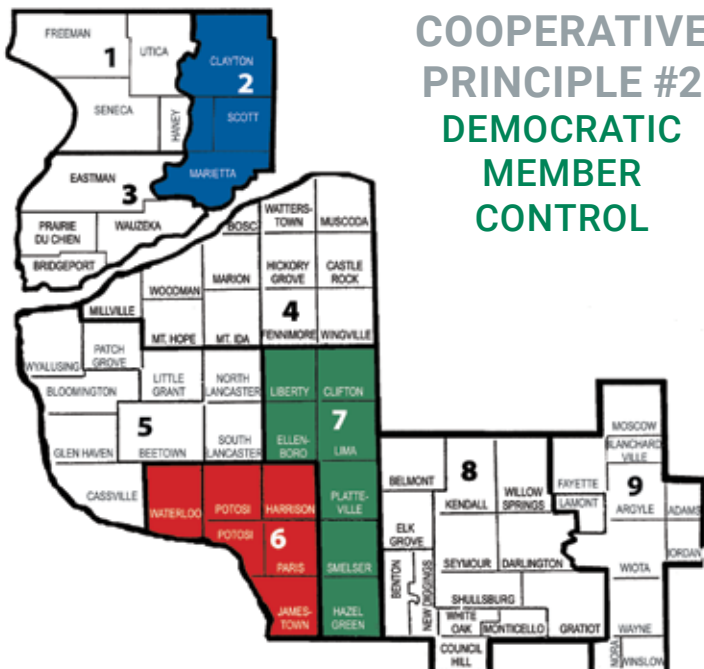
2025 DIRECTOR ELECTIONS
